

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

ROADWORKS ON RACECOURSE AND TURFHALL ROADS

JANUARY 2026

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of temporary lane closures along Racecourse and Turfhall Roads.

Work is planned to start between the Castor/Benona Road intersection and the M5 bridge from Tuesday 6 January 2026 for approximately 10 months.

- Two lanes will be open in the direction of the M5 bridge and one lane in the opposite direction.
- One lane will be open in each direction over the railway bridge between Leafmore Road and Flamingo Crescent.
- One lane will be open in the direction of Claremont between the Castor Road and Flamingo Crescent intersections.

Residents are also advised of the following:

- All work will pause for the annual builders' break on 12 December and resume on 6 January 2026. Security personnel will remain on site 24/7.
- The temporary closure of Crosscut Road is planned from early February 2026.
- The current lane closure on Chukker Road will be removed for the builders' break and resume from 6 January for approximately two more weeks.

This change is subject to change and weather dependent. Residents and motorists are encouraged to follow @myciti_phase2 on Facebook or X for updates.

The works will regrettably add to congestion, and motorists are advised to:

- Approach with caution and follow the signs in place
- Plan for longer journey times
- Make use of lift clubs, ride-sharing or public transport
- Avoid peak traffic times
