COMPLETION OF PEDESTRIAN BRIDGES MANENBERG

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate is pleased to announce the completion of the new pedestrian bridges spanning the Lotus Canal along Govan Mbeki Road.

Residents will be able to use the new pedestrian bridges from **14 September 2026**, with the demolition of the old bridges scheduled to commence shortly thereafter.

These bridges provide an important pedestrian link for nearby residents, ensuring safe and convenient access across the Lotus River Canal between Govan Mbeki Road and the Manenberg residential area.

The project forms part of the City's ongoing commitment to improving pedestrian safety, accessibility, and connectivity in communities across Cape Town. The new bridges offer enhanced safety through improved alignment, better visibility, and more secure crossing points for residents who travel between these areas on foot.

The City remains committed to minimising disruption and maintaining safe pedestrian access throughout the demolition process. We thank residents and road users for their patience, understanding, and cooperation during this period.
